

UPDATE A CURRENT FOSTER'S MEDICAL RECORDS

There are several medical requirements that must be met before your foster can be adopted. Mark each medical requirement complete so we know your kitty is ready for adoption.

EDIT YOUR FOSTER'S MEDICAL IN THE PROCESSING TAB:

VACCINES:

From your foster's profile summary, make sure you are in Edit mode (1) then select the Medical (2) tab.

Then select the Vaccines (3) tab.

Next select the blue Complete vaccine button (4).

SPAY/NEUTER:

Once your foster is fixed, please record it in the Medical tab. Select the Proc & Surg green tab (1) and then select the blue Record Procedure/Surgery button (2).

Record the date and type of procedure (Spay or Neuter) and proper clinic.

OTHER HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

To enter the other REQUIRED items for adoption:

- Deworming
- Flea Treatment
- FIV/FelV Testing

Make sure you are in the Medical Tab (1) then select Treatment (2), then the Complete Treatment button (3).

You can select the Quick Fill for most common treatments given. If multi-day, select first day given.

For the FIV/FelV test, select the Medical Tab (1) then select Diagnostic Tests (4), then the Complete Treatment button (3). There is a Quick Fill for the test.
